c. affirmed by the Community of Elders that they are both qualified and called to serve in the role of elder

As of May 2016, the LAGBC Community of Elders recommend to the congregation that both Pat Griffith and Lee Wadsworth be recognized as Elders. The final step of their recognition will be carried out in our Family Meeting on June 26, 2016 by a congregational vote asking this question: "Has this man been called of God to shepherd His people?" Each man must be approved by 75% of those members voting.

Many in our church family know both these men, yet we want to share a little biography of each man for your consideration.



Patrick "Pat" Griffith

I was born in Detroit, Michigan, September 30, 1952. Moved with parents to California in 1959. I grew up in Santa Fe Springs, graduated from Santa Fe High School, 1970. Served in the USAF 1971-1975, as Military Medic, stationed in Japan. Returned to Southern California, worked for Kaiser Hospital Bellflower for 3-1/2 years.

A co-worker shared his faith with me in December, 1975, and I received Christ as my Lord and Savior at age 23. Married Viola "Vi" Madrid in 1986, and became a step-dad to daughters Jennene and Adrienne. Our daughter Kaitlin came into our family in 1987. Served as volunteer Chaplain in Los Angeles County Jail and Terminal Island Federal Correction Prison, between 1985 and 1992.

Our oldest daughter, Jennene, became pregnant in 1992 at age 15. This was the beginning of our family's involvement in Teen Parent ministry. Together, Vi and I have served in this ministry called "TLC" to teen parents and their children for 24 years, under the direction of Southern California Youth For Christ.

My wife and I started attending Los Altos Grace Brethren Church in 2006. Our "TLC" children have been attending Green Oak Ranch since 2000. And we have found this to be a great church home for us and for our ministry. It is a great honor to be considered for the role of Elder, and I am looking forward to serving the congregation in that capacity.
