 - a. *Be strong and courageous, do not be afraid or terrified because of them for the Lord your God is with you, He will not forsake you.*

- 19. You are loved
 - a. *For I know the plans I have for you for welfare and not evil to give you a future and a hope.*
 - b. Jeremiah 29:11
- 20. Be Safe
 - a. *The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.*

- 21. No problem is too great
 - a. *Cast your burden upon the Lord and he shall sustain you; He will never suffer the righteous to be moved.*

 - a. *Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you I will hold you up with my victorious right hand.*
