What kinds of things are you thankful to God for?



John 4:13-14




# THIRSTY?

# DRINK


Now on the last day, the great day of the feast,

John 7:37-39




# DRINK

How do you think believers experience the flowing of the Holy Spirit?




## THE RIVER
