Welcome

Let's get to know each other. You can use this question during your meal together.

- What kinds of trouble did you get into as a kid? Who rescued you?

Worship

Let's enter the presence of God together.

Songs led by worship leader or worship resource or read Psalm 92:1-5 and declare what "works" you've seen God do lately.

Word

Let's interact with God's Word.

In the Old Testament the High Priest would offer animal sacrifices to atone (pay) for the sins of God's people.

Now, Jesus is described as our High Priest...

Read Hebrews 2:18; 4:15-16; 10:19-25

1. *What about Jesus' priesthood is most encouraging (4:14-15)?
2. Why is it hard for many people to trust the love of God? How would you explain the meaning of the priesthood of Jesus to a non-Christian? To someone who doesn't understand the OT sacrificial system?
3. Note the four "let us" statements (Heb. 10:22-25). What does each one mean? What incentives are given?
4. In what specific ways can you spur another Christian on toward love and good deeds? How have you been spurred on by others in this group?

Witness

Let's focus on who we can reach out to.

- What neighbors or friends can we reach out to with the kindness of the Lord this week?
