Let's Be Honest...

### Welcome

Let's get to know each other. You can use this question during your meal together.

 \*What religious practice did you once do just because everyone else did it that way, but you have since outgrown?

# Worship

Let's enter the presence of God together.

Songs led by worship leader or worship resource or read Psalm 136. Have one person read a verse and everyone join in the refrain; "His love endures forever!" As you read, give thanks for what God has done for you lately.

### Word

Let's interact with God's Word.

Read Acts 5:17-42

- 1. Of what do they accuse the apostles in 5:28? How is this different from what bothered them in 4:2?
- 2. What assertions in Peter's response (vv. 29-32) would arouse their fury? Why is Peter being so direct (see 4:1-12; 5:19-20)?
- 3. How do you think Peter's statement in verse 29 (and 4:19) may have influenced Gamaliel?
- 4. Flogging sometimes resulted in death. Why do you think the disciples considered it worth rejoicing that they suffered in Jesus' name?
- 5. How do you think you would feel if you were sent to jail for what you believe? How would your family feel? What would this do for your faith?
- 6. In what way has God set you free to honor him more fully?

### Witness

Let's focus on who we can reach out to.

 Read Acts 5:12-16. Pray for opportunities to bring God's healing touch to our neighborhood this week.
