#### Welcome

# Worship

Let's enter the presence of God together.

Songs led by worship leader or worship resource or read Psalm 21:1-6 and share how you've experienced "the glory of God" this week. Give Him praise.

### Word

Let's interact with God's Word.

Read Acts 9:1-31 (Saul's conversion)

- 1. \*Describe what happened in verses 3-9 from the viewpoint of one of Saul's companions.
- 2. How do you think Saul felt when confronted by Jesus (vv. 4-6)? Given his previous activities, what would he be thinking about during those 3 days of blindness and fasting (v. 9)?
- 3. How would you feel in Ananias' place? Since Jesus had already appeared to Saul directly, why this time would he want a person to go to him? What is significant about the way Ananias addresses Saul (v. 17)?
- 4. How did the Lord first get your attention? Was it in some dramatic event or something more subtle?
- 5. Who has played the role of Ananias in your life? To whom does the Lord want you to play that part?

#### Witness

Let's focus on who we can reach out to.

Pray for each other to hear what the Spirit is saying to you regarding who to talk to this week about Jesus and His love. Come back next week with stories.
