- 3. What was religious life like in Lystra?
- 4. What does Paul emphasize about God in his speech? How is his speech to this crowd (vv. 15-17) different from his previous sermon in the synagogue (see 13:17-41)? Why the difference? What lessons can we learn here about sharing the Gospel with different groups of people?
- 5. What was one of the biggest misunderstandings about Christianity you had to overcome before you could believe?
