The Gospel of Grace

Welcome

Let's get to know each other. You can use this question if you have a meal together.

- Are you the type of person who usually “goes with the crowd” or “does your own thing”?

Worship

Let's enter the presence of God together.

Songs led by worship leader or worship resource or read Psalm 141:1. It's only one verse -but a powerful one!- so maybe read it a few times and give space after each reading to write down what the Lord is speaking to you. Share.

Word

Let's interact with God's Word.

Read Galatians 2:1-10

1. When have you worked hard on something, only to have it turn out to be in vain?
2. Why was Paul concerned that his preaching to the Gentiles was “in vain”? (vs. 2)
3. Who were the “false brothers” (v. 4)? What were they doing to Paul and his ministry? With what results?
4. What response did Paul get from the disciples in Jerusalem? How would you have felt about Paul joining your group, knowing he had persecuted the church?
5. How does caring for the poor (v. 10) relate to proclaiming the Gospel of grace?
6. How do you feel when your beliefs are contrary to popular opinion? On what issue do you need to stand alone?

Witness

Let's focus on who we can reach out to.

7. Is there a neighbor or friend that would benefit from this group that we can pray for and invite?
